INFORMATION

- Parents must obtain the Years 8 to 12 Entry to DoE Selective High Schools Application Information which contains the application form. This can be obtained from the following website http://www.schools.nsw.edu.au/learning/7-12assessments/selective8 12.php
- The enrolment placement panel meets August / September, and **selective** positions are offered on the basis of established criteria and vacancies. Frequently there are no vacancies in which case no offers can be made. **Only information included with the application will be considered by the panel.**
- Travel or proximity to this school is not relevant to the Sefton High School enrolment criteria.
- You must provide
 - > completed original **DoE Year 8 to 12 Entry to Selective High Schools Application form**
 - > original of a handwritten **student statement** covering the following matters
 - Give details of your achievements in academic courses and competitions. Photocopies of award certificates may be attached.
 - Give details of participation in cocurricular activities (eg sport, music, debating).
 - Why you want to become a student at Sefton High School.
 - Outline how your personal attributes make you suitable for placement at Sefton High School.
 - photocopy of original full Birth Certificate for the child for whom you are requesting enrolment. If the child was born overseas, his/her passport and visa documents must also be provided
 - **photocopies of the two most recent school reports** (originals will not be accepted)
 - **photocopies** of any school or external awards gained in the last two years
 - **photocopy** of the most recent NAPLAN report
 - **photocopies** of any other documentation that may support the application.

NOTE

- Submission of the application form does not guarantee enrolment.
- The **penalty for providing false or misleading information** to a school when making an application for enrolment is up to 2 years imprisonment, \$22,000 fine or both in accordance with Section 307B of the Crimes Act 1900.
